In moments like these, we are reminded of the rhythm of our life in faith—the sacred pattern of death and rebirth, endings and new beginnings. We trust that God is present in every season, even those that bring change, guiding us with grace and love.

Tony has been a beloved and steady presence in the life of C2 for many years. His gifts have shaped our worship in profound ways, bringing joy, energy, and a deep sense of connection. We are truly grateful for all he has shared with this community, and we give thanks for his ministry among us.

In the weeks following Easter, we will gather for a Town Hall meeting for the C2 community. This will be a space to come together, share more, and—if it feels right at that time—we will figure out what it means to celebrate Tony.

Honest and compassionate conversation is one of the ways we continue to grow together in trust, grace, and understanding.
